PAY WAY Direct Debit

Direct debit by instalment is available via a bank facility which allows the school and preschool, where agreed in writing by a parent, to deduct a specified amount from either their credit/debit card or nominated bank account on a weekly, fortnightly or monthly basis for a nominated period, until the full debt is paid. Any parent wishing to set up a PAYWAY Recurring Billing option can obtain a direct debit request form from the Front Office.
