Dogs on School Sites

Please note that dogs are not permitted on any school site within South Australia without permission from the Principal at the school site.

South Australia Dog and Cat Management Act 1995

45A—Miscellaneous duties relating to dogs

- (2) A person who owns or is responsible for the control of a dog is guilty of an offence if the dog (not being an accredited disability dog, guide dog or hearing dog) is in, or in the grounds of, a school, kindergarten, child care centre or pre-school centre without the permission of the person in charge of that place.

Maximum penalty:

- (a) if the dog is a dangerous dog or a dog of a prescribed breed—\$2 500;
(b) in any other case—\$250.

Expiation fee:

- (a) if the dog is a dangerous dog or a dog of a prescribed breed—\$210;
(b) in any other case—\$80.

The person in charge is the Principal or Director

For visiting dogs, the Principal/Director should be aware that they are responsible for ensuring that appropriate arrangements are made to protect the safety of students/children and the welfare of the animals. No dog should be on site without their knowledge and permission as per the [Dog and Cat Management Act 1995](#) and regulations.

At no times should dogs be allowed to wander on school sites unrestrained or unsupervised.
